Our 2020 fundraising exhibition was very successful and thanks to the generosity of artists across both Lewis and Harris and beyond, we were able to raise over £2,500.00

This year we are asking artists to donate up to 5 postcard sized pieces of your original artwork which will be mounted and exhibited at the fundraising exhibition.

The donated artwork will be sold to raise funds in aid of **Bethesda Hospice** and **West Harris Trust Beach Access Fund** (the 2020 fundraiser contributed to the purchase of a beach accessible wheelchair.)

Alongside the exhibition at Talla na Mara, Artwork will be exhibited in an online gallery so that it is accessible to anyone wishing to buy a beautiful original miniature masterpiece in aid of our chosen charities.

All work will be sold at the same affordable price although purchasers are welcome to make additional donations. **Talla na Mara** has kindly agreed to waive commission on sales, so all moneys will go to the two chosen charities.

This will be a great opportunity to promote your own work and, at the same time, raise funds for worthy causes here on Lewis and Harris. - **Any medium** – drawing, watercolour, acrylic, mixed media, collage,
original print, textile, photograph etc
- signed on the front where possible
- **unmounted**
